

# The Colorado Mountain Ranch

## Bus Schedule

**WHERE:** Pick Up and Drop Off is at North Boulder Park (9<sup>th</sup> and Dellwood) near the parking lot (7<sup>th</sup> and Dellwood.)

➤ Please leave the park side of Dellwood open for our buses!

**WHEN:** **Morning:** Supervising staff arrive at 7:45 AM. Please arrive before 8:15 AM. (Horse Focus campers scheduled for the morning ride depart as soon as all are there.) The buses aim to leave for The Ranch at 8:30 AM after cross-referencing sign-ins and bus check-ons.

**Afternoon:** The buses aim to arrive at North Boulder Park at 4:30 PM. Horse (Horse Focus campers scheduled for the afternoon ride often arrive closer to 4:40 PM.) Staff members supervise until 5:15 PM each evening. **Please be sure to sign out** and have your child with you when you do. We try to call all parents who don't sign out to be sure that you have your child.

### Park Sign In and Sign Out

**Mornings:** Please sign in your child(ren), and indicate the time. Bathroom Call and Bus Loading begin at 8:10 AM. Once a child is on the bus, he/she must stay there. Sign-ins before 8:15 AM are cross-referenced with the bus check-on list. Parents who sign in a child after 8:15 AM are responsible for being sure their child is on the bus.

**Afternoons:** SIGN YOUR CHILD OUT on the same sheet you signed in on. Have your child with you when you sign out with our staff. A child may sign him/herself in or out only with written permission from the parent. Otherwise, your child may only be released to those you have indicated on your original registration. If there are changes, please let us know in writing. If you have last minute emergency changes in plans, call us before 3:30 PM so that the office can let your child and the park staff know. Only those authorized to sign out your child may do so.

**Bus Safety:** Please ask your child to:

- Remain seated, face forward and keep the aisles clear
- Not throw any objects
- Use inside voices, don't distract the driver
- Keep head, arms and any trash inside the bus
- Be courteous – keep hands and feet to self
- Raise hand to ask for help from the bus supervisor if needed
- Be alert to traffic when leaving the bus
